Among these, anthropometric height and weight data were obtained for 4007 of the children, 2314 boys and 2373 girls. BMI distribution was compared to a prior study of 4-year-old Swedish children born between 1971 and 1975. Researchers also compared levels of overweight and obese children amongst different socioeconomic levels using a survey (conducted by 4161 people) to discover the differences in occupation, education, and income in age-class stratified random samples of the population in the municipalities represented by the children in the study. These municipalities were ranked on these three factors and grouped into low-, medium, and high-socioeconomic status groups.</p> <p>Researchers found girls had higher levels of overweight and obesity than boys. When they looked at how these results related to socioeconomic status levels they found higher levels of overweight and obesity in municipalities with lower socioeconomic status levels. Also, the difference in levels of overweight and obesity between girls and boys was concentrated in areas of lower socioeconomic status.</p> <p>The mechanism of the link between higher childhood overweight and obesity levels is not fully known but lack of education that includes adequate health education and less nutritional knowledge play a part according to the authors. Why these and other differences make girls to situations of lower socioeconomic status more susceptible than boys to lower socioeconomic status is not clear.</p> | <p>I would like to study more about the link between overweight and obesity and lower socioeconomic status. It makes sense that there would tend to lower levels of knowledge about health practices and nutrition among groups with lower socioeconomic status but I think that other factors of differences in culture might be as important as general knowledge about health. I think families with lower socioeconomic status probably have less supervision of children in all areas, including areas of eating and physical activity. I also think practices such as parents being home to eat with their children and modeling healthy eating patterns is important. I hypothesize that some of the reasons of having lower socioeconomic status put pressure on parents and children in these situations such that having healthy eating and physical activity practices are much further down in their hierarchy of needs. Parents might well have their energies consumed by managing other parts of theirs and their children's lives and may have little involvement in providing care and teaching of their children's lives whereas parents from high socioeconomic status backgrounds would have fewer other sources and thus be able to focus on raising their children to have about and practice healthy behaviors regarding food and physical activity.</p> <p>While I know the focus of this article is to report about the findings of a specific study, I think exploring possible explanations of the findings would be an intriguing addition to the discussion of the findings. For instance, I think exploring the differences between how boys and girls are affected by socioeconomic status is a very interesting area to explore. I think traditional gender differences might play a role here – that girls of all ages are less supported in maintaining adequate levels of physical activity – but I'm not sure how the socioeconomic status plays a part.</p> |
